Summer Institute 2011 Daily Schedule

Monday, August 29

8:30 - 11:30 am

1. Focus on Full Day Kindergarten

Facilitators: Gretchen Tolfo & Early Learning Team

This fast-paced session will provide new and experienced Kindergarten teachers with a wealth of strategies and picture book resources for an exciting year of Full Day Kindergarten. Participants will explore how to create a safe classroom environment for interactive curriculum rooted in play, and discover engaging ways of linking language, literacy and numeracy for early learners. Instructional activities from *Our Turn To Talk*, *Firm Foundations* and *Inspirations 44* will be featured.

2. Focus on Math

Facilitators: Shannon Sharp

Math 44 is a supporting document for classroom teachers of mathematics; based on current research and pedagogy. This workshop is designed to introduce participants to the document, some of the mathematics activities, the use of manipulatives and a problem based approach to instruction.

1. Focus on Reading - Primary

Facilitators: Gretchen Tolfo & Primary Literacy Team

In this session, participants will explore a framework for interactive literacy that includes pre-reading (connecting), during-reading (processing), and post-reading (extending) instructional activities. Oral language will provide the foundation for the development of the 12 Reading Strategies outlined in *Reading 44 Primary*. Featuring new children's literature selections, this session will highlight the important role that the reading-writing connection plays in motivating and engaging students in reading.

2. Focus on Reading - Intermediate

Facilitators: Joanne Robertson & Intermediate Literacy Team

In this session, participants will explore a framework for interactive literacy that includes pre-reading (connecting), during-reading (processing), and post-reading (extending) instructional activities. Oral language and critical thinking activities will enhance students' development of the 12 Reading Strategies, as outlined in *Reading 44 Intermediate*, that may be applied to both fiction and non-fiction text.

3. Focus on Reading - Secondary

Facilitators: District Secondary Literacy 44 Team

In this session, participants will explore a framework for critical literacy that includes pre-reading (connecting), during-reading (processing), and post-reading (extending) instructional activities. A cross-curricular approach to the development of students' repertoire of reading strategies (as outlined in *Reading 44 Secondary*) will be featured, as well as practical ideas for encouraging students to be active participants in the reading process and to develop a critical, reflective and personal approach to text.

1. Focus on Writing - Primary

Facilitators: Gretchen Tolfo & Primary Literacy Team

In this session, participants will learn how to model and provide explicit instruction in the Eight Writing Skills, as outlined in *Writing 44 Primary*. Effective and engaging instructional activities and a strong oral language thread support all learners in the writing process. The recursive process of conversation, writing instruction and practice will be highlighted throughout the session.

2. Focus on Writing - Intermediate

Facilitators: Joanne Robertson & Intermediate Literacy Team

In this session, participants will learn how to model and provide explicit instruction in the Eight Writing Skills, as outlined in *Writing 44 Intermediate*, through effective and engaging instructional activities. Oral language development, assessment strategies and the reading-writing connection will be highlighted throughout the session.

3. Critical Literacy Strategies - Secondary

Facilitators: District Secondary Literacy 44 Team

In this session, participants will receive creative, yet practical advice about teaching at the Secondary level. Using the *Writing 44 Secondary* document, participants will learn how to teach the Eight Writing Skills using engaging instructional activities. Appreciation of the writing process, adaptation to different modes and purposes, and meaningful assessment will be highlighted throughout the session.
